

# What is a MEF Wiki task (Wiki)

<b>Question</b>	What is a MEF Wiki task?
<b>Answer</b>	<p>The MEF Wiki provides a way to make everyone more productive so they can get more work done, together. The key is focusing on the most important deliverables, and eliminating distractions while you work on them. This includes streamlining where a group of people work and how that group tracks the progress of its work.</p> <p>Tasks in Confluence are different from task management apps. Tasks are tightly integrated with all of your work in the MEF Wiki. They're contextual.
